The student must pass a final exam designed and approved by the appropriate academic department and may receive tutoring for a maximum of one (1) credit per school year.

Students may not receive tutoring in the same subject area in consecutive years. Subject areas include: Math, English, Social Studies, and Science.

All tutoring arrangements must be made by a guidance counselor and approved by the principal. Fees will be negotiated directly with the tutor.
