<p>1. Purpose SC 1807, 1841</p>	<p>The Joint Operating Committee shall operate the Carbon Career & Technical Institute for the benefit of students who are residents in one of the participating districts.</p>
<p>2. Authority SC 1809, 1847, 1850.1</p> <p>SC 1809, 1847 1850.1</p>	<p>The Joint Operating Committee may admit nonresident students from outside the Carbon Career & Technical Institute's participating school districts' geographic boundaries if space will warrant such admission, and an appropriate program can be provided.</p> <p>Nonresident students may be admitted upon payment of annually established tuition rates.</p>
<p>3. Delegation of Responsibility</p> <p>School Code 1807, 1809, 1841, 1847, 1850.1</p> <p>Joint Operating Committee Policy 103</p>	<p>The Administrative Director shall develop procedures for the enrollment of nonresident students.</p>
<p>4. Guidelines</p>	<p>Affidavits shall be secured in duplicate from the legally appointed representative of any student whose residence is questionable. One copy of the affidavit shall be placed in the student's cumulative folder and one copy shall be forwarded to the Carbon Career & Technical Institute's Office.</p> <p>Tuition Rate</p> <p>The secondary student tuition rate for students from nonparticipating school districts shall be based on the September 15th enrollment figures each year.</p> <p>The amount charged will be derived by subtracting the adult education, learning</p>

	<p>support costs, and secondary federal program costs from the total budget. If the student from the nonparticipating district is identified as a special needs student, additional costs will be charged using the same formula as is used for member districts.</p> <p>The Carbon Career & Technical Institute will bill districts toward the beginning of each semester. Reconciliation will be made using the same formula as is used for member districts with an addition of a capital expenditure charge added to the cost.</p> <p>In the event a student returns to his/her home district, the tuition charged would be adjusted to reflect the dates during which the non-resident student was actually enrolled.</p>
