	204.1. NONSCHOOL-SPONSORED EDUCATION TRIPS OR TOURS
1. Purpose	The principal may grant a student permission to be legally excused from school attendance for an activity that provides for an enriching education experience for the student.
2. Delegation of Responsibility	The parent/guardian shall be responsible for submitting the application to the school office at least one (1) week prior to the activity.
3. Guidelines	The application should state the name, dates, and location of the education experience the student will receive and explain the educational value.
	Students are responsible for securing the initials of all the assigned teachers before submitting the form for consideration.
	The student will be required to secure and complete all classroom assignments that occur during the absence.
	Trips will be limited to one (1) per year and normally not to exceed five (5) days in length.
	Trips that include days of final exams or achievement tests will not be approved.
	Such activities must be under the direction and supervision of an adult acceptable to the principal.
	Exceptions to the limitations outlined above will require special provisions for alternate attendance, tutoring and make-up work.
