| 215A. CLASS RANK | |
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| 1. Purpose | The JOC acknowledges the usefulness of a system of computing grade point averages and class ranking for secondary school graduates to inform students, parents/guardians and others of their relative academic placement among their peers under relatively similar circumstances. |
| 2. Authority | The JOC authorizes a system of class ranking based on grade percentage, for full-time students in grades 10 through 12. |
| 3. Guidelines | <p>Class rank shall be computed by the final grade in all subjects.</p> <p>Any two (2) or more students whose computed grade point averages are identical shall be given the same rank. The rank of the student who immediately follows a tied position will be determined by the number of students preceding him/her and not by the rank of the person preceding him/her.</p> <p>A student's grade point average and rank in class shall be entered on his/her record and shall be subject to the JOC policy on release of student records.</p> |
| 4. Delegation of Responsibility | <p>The Administrative Director and Principal shall develop procedures for the computation of grade point averages and the assignment of rank in class to implement this policy.</p> <p>References:</p> <p>School Code – 24 P.S. Sec. 510</p> |
