228. STUDENT GOVERNMENT	
<p>1. Purpose</p>	<p>The Joint Operating Committee acknowledges the importance of offering students the opportunity to participate in self government within the school.</p> <p>The purpose of student government shall be to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Develop student leadership.</li> <li>2. Provide a learning experience in democratic decision-making.</li> <li>3. Offer another avenue toward the realization of goals.</li> </ol>
<p>2. Authority SC 511, 1850.1</p>	<p>The Joint Operating Committee establishes that students shall have the right to organize, conduct meetings, elect officers and representatives, and petition the Joint Operating Committee.</p> <p>The Joint Operating Committee will recognize the Student Council as the official voice of the student body.</p>
<p>SC 511</p>	<p>The Joint Operating Committee shall appoint a qualified member of the faculty to serve as an advisor for student government activities.</p>
<p>3. Delegation of Responsibility</p>	<p>The Administrative Director or designee shall establish rules and regulations to implement this policy which:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Assure that all students have equal access to the student government and an equal opportunity to vote and hold office.</li> <li>2. Require fiscal accountability and adherence to Joint Operating Committee policy for all financial aspects of student government activity.</li> </ol>
