810.1. DRUG/ALCOHOL TESTING - COVERED DRIVERS	
1. Purpose	The Joint Operating Committee recognizes that the use and abuse of drugs and alcohol is a serious problem that may be present in the workplace. The Joint Operating Committee also recognizes that a employee driver or transporter of student impaired by drugs or alcohol poses significant risks to the safety of students and others.
2. Definition	<p>A covered driver shall mean any school employee who drives or operates a motor vehicle with a gross vehicle weight rating of 26,001 or more pounds or is designed to transport sixteen (16) or more passengers, including the driver; or any other school employee who is regularly assigned to drive a school vehicle of any size or kind.</p> <p>The phrase includes drivers and mechanics who operate such vehicles, including full-time, regularly employed individuals; casual, intermittent or occasional individuals; and leased drivers and independent owner-operator contractors who are either directly employed by or under lease to the school or who operate a bus owned or leased by the school.</p>

Authority SC 510, 1850.1 49 CFR Sec. 382.305	The Joint Operating Committee establishes that transportation companies contracted by the Joint Operating Committee or its member districts shall provide a program of drug and alcohol testing for covered drivers. A statement ensuring such program shall be included in the contracted agreement.
