905. CITIZEN ADVISORY COMMITTEES

1. Purpose

The Joint Operating Committee recognizes the value of Citizen Advisory Committees. It believes that they are useful in providing information with regard to community opinion and in representing the community in the study of specific school problems.

2. Guidelines

The Joint Operating Committee shall define any new committee assignment and shall:

- 1. Approve members who are interested and can make some special contribution to the committee's function.
- **2.** Approve recommendations by the Administrative Director of staff members and/or students to the committee.
- **3.** Approve recommendations by the Administrative Director of citizens.
- **4.** Approve a recommendation by the Administrative Director of a chairperson(s).

In charging a new advisory committee, the Joint Operating Committee shall set a timeline for progress and reporting.

Recommendations of Citizen Advisory Committees shall not reduce the responsibility of the Joint Operating Committee, which shall be free to accept or reject the recommendations as it sees fit.

Meetings of a Citizen Advisory Committee are not regular meetings of the Joint Operating Committee and shall be open to the public only upon the invitation of the Committee.
