116. TUTORIAL INSTRUCTION							
1. Purpose	Students may utilize private tutoring by a certified teacher as a means to achieve a passing grade for a course that has been previously failed. Students will not be permitted to receive private tutoring in place of taking a course during the regular school year.

Guidelines	<p>Hourly requirements:</p> <table style="width: 100%; border: none;"> <tr> <td style="width: 60%;">1 Credit Course</td> <td style="text-align: right;">36 Hours of Tutoring</td> </tr> <tr> <td>½ Credit Course</td> <td style="text-align: right;">18 Hours of Tutoring</td> </tr> <tr> <td>Course Less Than ½ Credit</td> <td style="text-align: right;">18 Hours of Tutoring</td> </tr> </table> <p>The student must pass a final exam designed and approved by the appropriate academic department and may receive tutoring for a maximum of one (1) credit per school year.</p> <p>Students may not receive tutoring in the same subject area in consecutive years. Subject areas include: Math, English, Social Studies, and Science.</p> <p>All tutoring arrangements must be made by a guidance counselor and approved by the principal. Fees will be negotiated directly with the tutor.</p>	1 Credit Course	36 Hours of Tutoring	½ Credit Course	18 Hours of Tutoring	Course Less Than ½ Credit	18 Hours of Tutoring
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
