202. ELIGIBILITY OF NONRESIDENT STUDENTS

1. Purpose SC 1807, 1841

The Joint Operating Committee operates the Carbon Career & Technical Institute for the benefit of students who are residents of its participating school districts.

2. Authority SC 1809, 1847, 1850.1

The Joint Operating Committee may admit nonresident students from outside Carbon County if space warrants such admission and an appropriate program can be provided.

SC 1809, 1847, 1850.1

Nonresident students may be admitted upon payment of annually established tuition rates.

3. Delegation of Responsibility

The Administrative Director or designee shall develop procedures for the enrollment of nonresident students.

4. Guidelines

Affidavits shall be secured in duplicate from the legally appointed representative of any student whose residence is questionable. A copy of the affidavit shall be placed in the student's cumulative folder.

The tuition rate for students from outside of Carbon County shall be based on September enrollment figures each year.

The Carbon Career & Technical Institute shall bill districts at the beginning of each semester. Reconciliation will be made using the same formula as is used for member districts with addition of a capital expenditure charge added to the cost.

In the event a student withdraws from the school, the tuition charged shall be adjusted to reflect the dates during which the nonresident student was actually enrolled.
