Description of Topics

Post-Secondary Options

Workshop: Students will receive a presentation on post-secondary education options and what to expect as a college student. They will complete activities to learn the difference between high school and college and will also receive a presentation on different options after high school (trade school, military, other training programs).

Activity: Students will participate in a college time management activity to work on developing appropriate time management skills.

Travel Training Workshop: Students will be provided with a travel training workshop on how to access and use public transportation.

College Tour: Students will travel to Northampton Community College via the LANTA Bus system. They will learn about the services available to help them succeed in a post-secondary education setting, including information from the Disability Services department.

Activity: Students will participate in a scavenger hunt to help learn more about navigating a college campus.

Workplace Readiness

Workshop: Students will receive a presentation on work readiness topics including social media & employment, professionalism and self-management in the workplace.

Activity: Students will participate in a tour of the PA CareerLink® to explore the services they offer.

Independent Living Skills

Workshop: Students will learn about budgeting and money management skills.

Activity: Students will participate in a grocery store budgeting activity to learn skills to manage their money.

Workshop: Students will receive a presentation on employer expectations.

Employer Tour: Students will learn about employment options in the Lehigh Valley. They will travel to a local employer via the LANTA bus to learn about an array of career opportunities.

Activity: Students will travel via the LANTA bus to a local store to practice utilizing money management skills.

Activity: Students will participate in an activity to review what they learned during the week.
