1. Purpose	Purpose Professional employees set an example in dress and grooming for their students to follow and should present an image of dignity and encourage respect for authority. These factors act in a positive manner towards the maintenance of school and classroom discipline.
2. Authority SC 1850.1	Authority The Joint Operating Committee has the authority to specify reasonable dress and grooming guidelines for staff, within law, that will prevent an adverse impact on the educational process.
3. Guidelines	Guidelines Professional staff members shall be physically clean, neat, well-groomed, and dressed in a manner reflecting professional assignment and the industry standards for career and technical program personnel.
4. Delegation of Responsibility	Delegation of Responsibility If an employee feels that an exception to this policy because of special circumstances would facilitate the completion of assigned duties, a request should be made to the principal.
