

Carbon County Transportation Services for Families Experiencing Homelessness

Carbon County PA offers transportation for homeless families primarily through the [Medical Assistance Transportation Program](https://www.pa.gov/services/dhs/medical-assistance-transportation-program) (MATP) for qualifying medical trips and the Carbon County Community Transit (CCCT) Shared Ride program for eligible individuals. These services provide door-to-door, van, or taxi transport for appointments, which require advance reservations.

Key Transportation Options in Carbon County

- **MATP (Medical Assistance Transportation Program):** Provides free, non-emergency medical transportation to eligible riders, including medical transportation for children under 18 with a parent/guardian. Services may include, but are not limited to, vans or mileage reimbursement for appointments.
